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Red + MRS Fine Titanium Derma Roller

One treatment I have always wanted to try but I have not had a chance to, until recently, is dermal rolling. But last month I finally got the opportunity to sample what has undoubtedly become one of the most popular low-downtime treatments to emerge in recent years.



Aesthetic nurse Frances Furlong performed the treatment for me using the Red + MRS Fine Titanium Derma Roller. She also used a cocktail of mesotherapy products in combination with the dermal rolling to enhance my results as the needling helps aid penetration of active ingredients.



I was a little anxious about whether or not the treatment would be painful, however, after 20 minutes wearing local anaesthetic cream on my face I need not have worried. Although I felt a sensation of heat and a mild amount of discomfort, I was pleasantly surprised at how non-invasive a treatment that involves having needles run all over your skin actually was.

Immediately post treatment my skin was quite red and had the appearance of sunburn but after Frances applied a tinted SPF I left the clinic without any make-up on and went out for lunch! Over the next few days the appearance of my skin definitely improved, especially around the chin where I had a few spots. I am booked in for a second treatment in six weeks time and would definitely recommend this to anyone hoping to improve the appearance of their skin.

The Red + MRS Fine Titanium Derma Rollers have just been introduced to the UK market by Inspira Med and include both in-clinic and at-home devices ranging in sizes from 0.20mm-0.30mm for home use and 0.50mm-3.00mm for professional use. All rollers are delivered in individual sealed sterile envelopes and plastic cases.
