ASHLEE is a good looking girl though it would appear she may have had cosmetic surgery to reshape her nose.

The tip is a lot shorter and refined on the second picture and she now has a perfect little button nose.

She probably works out to keep herself in great shape. She has age on her side, so I don't think she has had any other work done on her face, apart from on her teeth.

EXPERTS' VERDICT

FRANCES Furlong, nurse practitioner at City Skinklinic (0870 751 3870, www.cityskinklinic.co.uk)

WOW! What a difference: The most obvious changes are her hair and make-up.

Her skin looks immaculate in both pictures, probably due to regular use of Intense Pulse Light, premium treatments that boost collagen, break down brown patches and ease any flushing.

Her nose appears to be straighter at the bridge and while one option can be surgery, a hyaluronic filler can be used to help even out imperfections.

GIRLS Aloud beauty Sarah Harding has been looking a tad surprised lately, which has got the rumour mill churning as to how her eyebrows always remain so perfectly arched these days.

The 24-year-old's skin also appears to have become more radiant since she first found fame three years ago. So is it all down to the sweet taste of pop success or has Sarah given her luscious looks a helping hand? Here's what our experts think.

FRANCES FURLONG, nurse practitioner at City Skinklinic (0870 751 3870 or www.cityskinklinic.co.uk):

EVIDENCE of sun damage (brown patches and freckles) in the first picture have disappeared in the later one.

This can be achieved through Intense Pulsed Light treatments, or skin peeling, depending on the damage. Her skin looks wonderful.

These treatments also boost collagen, which gives the skin a more youthful look.

The horizontal lines on the outside of her forehead and elevated eyebrows indicate the possible use of Botox.

Her lips are clearly defined and I feel she may have had a soft collagen filler to plump up the lips.

SARAH'S skin looks a lot smoother and more refined in the later picture.

This could have been achieved through microdermabrasion, a popular choice for removing old, sun-damaged skin, which results in a fresher, younger look.

Her eyebrows now do look unnaturally high, with the forehead area very smooth and looking slightly pulled-back.

One answer for this could be a brow lift. At 24 she does seem very young to have undergone this procedure but some people don't like to leave it until they've gone to seed.

Alternatively she may have used botox for a similar effect.

But whether she's an expectant mum-to-be or not there's no doubt she looks as fresh as when she started out on planet showbiz in the 90s. So what's Gwen's secret for eternal youth? Here's our experts' views.

FRANCES FURLONG, nurse practitioner at City Skinklinic (0870 751 3870 or www.cityskinklinic.co.uk)

Gwen has well proportioned features and good skin with no evidence of sun damage in either picture, which suggests she uses a high SPF cream as well as an intensive Vitamin C serum to protect the skin and boost collagen.

In the above right picture it looks as if she's had Botox to achieve the eyebrow elevation; this can also be achieved with a procedure called Threadlift.

Gwen's skin does not seem to have aged much which could be down to regular glycol-

ic peels or IPL (Photo-rejuvenation) to maintain the collagen levels in the skin and promote a fresher look.

Gwen has good genes and has aged well. She probably has regular facials and skin treatments and she may also have had a facial peel to diminish fine lines as her skin looks fabulous and very smooth.
