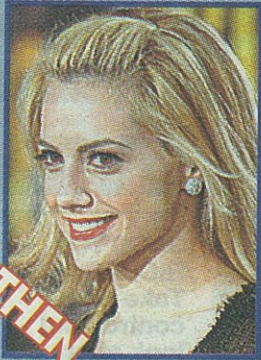

BRITTANY is a good looking girl and still very young, so I doubt if she's had much done.

However, her upper lip does seem bigger in the second photo, which would suggest the use of collagen.

Her skin looks fabulous and smooth, so she probably has regular facials to keep her looking her best. She may also have had a facial peel to diminish fine lines.

But as one of Hollywood's bright young stars and with access to the world's best beauticians, it's not surprising she looks as great as she does.

IT is difficult to assess if she has had much done, especially because she has a fringe covering her forehead in the second photo

Although she has excellent skin, the dark brown hair she now has ages her, drawing attention to creases in the cheeks, circles under the eyes and crow's feet at the corners of the eyes.

She is obviously prone to eyebags and dark circles, which can be clearly seen in both photos. Botox and Intense Pulsed Light treatment would help.

Mesotherapy treatment using vitamin C would improve the dark circles.

THERE'S not a shadow of doubt that Celebrity BB housemate Pete Burns has a penchant for the surgeon's knife. On the plus side, his skin is remarkably well preserved for a 46-year-old. But what about the rest of his looks? Here's what our experts reckon.

MARY BURNEY, director of clinical services at Transform Medical Group, the UK's largest cosmetic surgery group (0500 202020)

HE has what is known as Paris lips, in which both the outline and the body are enhanced.

Most people look only to enhance, not exaggerate their lips.

He also has few wrinkles on his face, suggesting he has non-surgical treatments such as Botox and dermal fillers.

Sadly, he has lost his good looks, and has had this amount of surgery simply to draw attention to himself.

In my experience, this is not the result people want to attain from cosmetic surgery.

COMPARED to the first picture, Pete's lips are now swollen and unnatural looking, which could indicate an allergic reaction to the substance or implant used.

The eyes look more defined and the eyebrows are more lifted. This could have been achieved with Botox and thread lifting.

The eyebrow shape and the eyeline definition could have been emphasised with permanent makeup.

His skin looks very good in both pictures, indicating use of SPF and Vitamin C serum.

There are even rumours she may have had some help with those lovely lady lumps. So what do our experts reckon?

FRANCES FURLONG, nurse practitioner at City Skinklinic (0870 751 3870 or www.cityskinklinic.co.uk): Possible cheek enhancement such as Bio-Alcamid™, which plumps up the cheeks. Her skin is lovely and bright. Regular glycolic peels or a course of IPL treatments can help boost collagen and remove any blemishes and sun damage.

MARY BURNEY, director of clinical services at Transform Medical Group, the UK's largest cosmetic surgery group (0500 202020): It certainly appears she's had some work done. Her breasts look more rounded at the top than natural ones and she may have had surgical work on her nose and lips.
