She probably has had treatment with Intense Pulsed Light (IPL). Her face looks fuller

which is possibly due to weight gain during pregnancy. Her lips also appear to have more volume. Restylane Lipp is a lip filler that gives a lovely soft full look.

Her skin now looks radiant and her grooming and posture is immaculate.

Her eyelashes look thicker and this can be achieved with eyeliner done with permanent

make-up.

IN the then picture, Prince's skin appears to have an uneven tone with darker patches, a common problem with darker skins.

This is down to their higher melanin content, so it is vital even those with dark skins use a daily sun protection with a high SPF.

His skin looks immaculate in the now picture. It could be make-up, but treatments such as microdermabrasion and depigmenting may have contributed.

His eyebrows are more arched. This can be achieved with a thread lift and fillers placed under the outer edge of the eyebrow.

A muscle relaxant may have been used to smooth his forehead.

His lips are now fuller and plumper. Restylane Lipp can give this effect.

His nasal-labial lines are far less pronounced in the now picture suggesting filler use such as Restylane or Perlane. His eyebrows also look considerably high-


er and his forehead very smooth.
