NANCY'S GOT IT

HER time with the former England manager Sven Goran Eriksson, 58, might have been turbulent but the years have clearly been kind to Nancy Dell'Olio's appearance.

Stresses and strains do not appear to have taken their toll on Nancy's looks and at 47 she is remarkably well-preserved. So what's her secret and has she had a little extra help along the way? Here's what our experts reckon.

The Experts' verdict

FRANCES Furlong, nurse practitioner at City Skinklinic (0870 751 3870 or www.cityskinklinic.co.uk)

WOMEN with exceptionally good bone structure like Nancy tend to age well but the after picture shows the possibility that she has had a thread lift as there is more definition to the jaw line.

Even though she is tanned, there is little evidence of sun damage but she may have had photorejuvenation with IPL.

And the absence of wrinkles in the upper part of her face would indicate the use of muscle-relaxing injections.

MARY BURNEY, clinical services director at Transform Medical Group, the UK's largest cosmetic surgery group (0500 202020)

ALTHOUGH her type of olive skin does age well, I think her appearance is also the result of a rather a lot of non-surgical treatments on her face.

Her lips look remarkably plump, which could indicate collagen injections (from £200). She may also have had dermal fillers on the lines from nose-to-mouth (from £200), while Botox (from £200) may have been used to smooth wrinkles. She has probably also had a facial peel (from £500).

First-up there's the break-up of her marriage to husband Nick Lachey, 32. Then there are the on-going rumours that the lovely Jess, 25, has had a little outside help with her luscious looks. So what do our experts reckon...?

MARY BURNEY, director of clinical services at Transform Medical Group, the UK's largest cosmetic surgery group (0500 202020):

THE photos suggest that Jessica has what are known as "Paris" lips, in which the outline and the body of the lips are both enhanced, rather than just the outline.

Her eyebrows also appear to be very high which is achieved with the use of Botox in the forehead. No one's eyebrows are that high naturally.

Her nose appears slimmer in the second photo, suggesting that she's had her nose-tip reshaped.

She was a beautiful girl to start with, but it appears that she's had a helping hand.

FRANCES FURLONG, nurse practitioner at City Skinklinic (0870 751 3870 or www.cityskinklinic.co.uk):

JESSICA'S eyebrows are now more arched and elevated, which indicates the use of Botox or thread lifting.

Eye-brow grooming could also have been enhanced with the use of permanent make-up (micropigmentation) with the colour being toned to match her new hair colour.

She has also been on an intense diet and fitness programme, which could account for the change in the shape of her face.

This lifting and modelling can also be achieved with a procedure called thread lifting, done with local anaesthetic. It can also be used to lift brows.
